

Disability Tuition Waiver Continuing Education Courses

Due to changes in Maryland State law, Anne Arundel Community College has changed the Waivers to Tuition Policy for Maryland disabled residents who are out of the workforce or retired by reason of total and permanent disability, and receiving disability benefits or supplemental security income as defined by the Social Security Administration, Railroad Retirement Board, or the federal retirement or pension authority (U.S. Office of Personnel Management). The disability waiver can be used for certain noncredit continuing education classes. Qualified classes are those designed to lead to employment, including life skills.

Submit this signed form to the Cashier's Office prior to the beginning of each term with the required payment.
